प्रस्तावना

हम, भारत के लोग, भारत को संपूर्ण प्रभुत्वसंपन्न, समाजवादी, पंथनिरपेक्ष, लोकतांत्रिक गणराज्य बनाने के लिए तथा उसके समस्त नागरिकों को सामाजिक आर्थिक और राजनीतिक न्याय, विचार, अभिव्यक्ति, विश्वास, धर्म और उपासना की स्वतंत्रता; प्रतिष्ठा और अवसर की समता, प्राप्त कराने के लिए; तथा उन सबमें व्यक्ति की गरिमा और राष्ट्र की एकता और अखंडता सुनिश्चित करने वाला बंधुत्व बढ़ाने के लिए दृढ़संकल्प होकर अपनी इस संविधान सभा में आज दिनांक 26 नवम्बर 1949 ई को एतद्द्वारा इस संविधान को अंगीकृत, अधिनियमित और आत्मार्पित करते हैं।

THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

THE PREAMBLE

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India, into a **SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC** and to secure all its citizens ;

JUSTICE : social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status of opportunity and to promote among them all;

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation;

In our constituent assembly this Twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do **HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.**

THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

Chapter IV - A

Our Fundamental Duties

ARTICLE 51-A

Fundamental Duties- It shall be the duty of every citizen of India -

- (a) to abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem;
- (b) to cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom;
- (c) to uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India;
- (d) to defend the country and render National Service when called upon to do so;
- (e) to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women;
- (f) to value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture;
- (g) to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes and rivers, wild life and to have compassion for living creatures;
- (h) to develop Scientific Temper, Humanism and the Spirit of inquiry and reform;
- (i) to safeguard public property and to abjure violence;
- (j) to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity to that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement.

EXEMPTION

1. If more than one child of the same parent is studying in class IX-XII in case of both boys same KV, and not covered under any reimbursement scheme, the child in the higher class shall pay full tuition fee and the other only half tuition fee. But they are not exempted from the payment of VVN and computer fee.
2. Girl students and students belonging SC/ST category are exempted from payment of tuition fee in case they are not covered under CEA/ Reimbursement scheme by the department where their parents are serving.
3. From Class VI onwards Single girl child too if not covered under CEA/ any Reimbursement scheme by the department her parents are

serving shall be exempted from the payment of Tuition fee & VVN Fund.

4. Children belonging to SC/ST including disabled & disadvantages group like economically weaker sections, socially weaker sections admitted under RTE shall be exempted from the payment of admission fee, VVN & comp fund besides other concessions.

Mode of Payment

Tuition fee, VVN and computer fee is payable for all the 12 months of the school academic year and is payable in advance quarterly by the 15th of each quarter i.e **April, July, October and January**. Thereafter a fine of Rs. 5 per day will be charged upto last working day of the month. After that the name will be struck off due to non payment of fee. Similarly a fine of Rs. 5/- per day towards higher contribution on VVN will be charged if it is delayed upto last working day of the month, after which the name will be struck off from the rolls.

Re-admission Fee: Rs. 100/- will be charged in addition to late fee if the name has been struck off due to non payment or otherwise, along with fine of Rs. 5 per day.

No fees will be collected in the Vidyalaya. However, parents may pay the fees at any branch of UBI. Student user-id is mentioned in the Bank-Challan and keep the user-ID for online payment.

Method of Admission

For Class - I	Admission is based on priority of above mentioned categories 25% admission will be under RTE act 2009.

RESERVATION

- (a) 15% Seats for Scheduled Cast and 7.5% seats for Scheduled Tribes shall be reserved in all fresh admission in all Kendriya Vidyalayas
- (b) 3% Seats of total available seats for fresh admission will be horizontally reserved for differently able children.

MINIMUM ATTENDANCE

A pupil will not be allowed to sit in the Annual Examination if he/she has not put in a minimum of 75% of the total attendance of the academic session including attendance put in the previous school, if the student has been admitted on transfer.

Periodic Test (10 marks)

The school should conduct three periodic written tests in the entire academic year and the average of the best two will be taken. The schools have the autonomy to make its own schedule. However, for the purpose of gradient learning, three tests may be held as one being the mid-term test and other the two being pre mid and post mid-term with portion of syllabus cumulatively covered. The gradually increasing portion of contents would prepare students acquire confidence for appearing in the Board examination with 100% syllabus. The school will take the average of the best two test for final marks submission.

(iii) Subject Enrichment Activities (5 marks)

These are subject specific application activities aimed at enrichment of the understanding and skill development. These activities are to be recorded internally by respective teachers.

For Language : Activities conducted for subject enrichment in language should aim at equipping the learner to develop effective speaking and listening skills.

For Mathematics : The listed laboratory activities and projects as given in the prescribed publication of CBSE/NCERT may be followed.

For Science : The listed practical works / activities may be carried out as prescribed by the CBSE in the curriculum.

Class XII, the board will conduct the external examination at the end of the session. Pattern of the class XI for periodic tests and half yearly will be followed in class XII also.

Details regarding design of question paper, blue print and progress report will be provided in due course.

WITHDRAWAL :

At least 3 days notice in writing on a prescribed form is to be given duly signed by the guardian before withdrawing a student from the school.

MEDICAL FACILITIES :

1. The nurse has been appointed by the school for medical check up.
2. Medical checkup of the students is held twice a year and routine check up when it is required.

SCHOOL LIBRARY AND READING ROOMS :

Each child is expected to make full use of the school library and the reading room. He/she shall get one book at a time for one week on his/her card. He / she may be allowed to have two books at a time on special recommendation of the class/subject teacher.

Children should observe the rules of the Library/Reading rooms as enforced from time to time.

Children are expected to return the books in time i.e. in one week, else a fine of Re. 1/- per day or so imposed by the Principal shall be levied on them.

Students are required to keep record of their reading and submit report of at least two books in every term.

CONDONATION OF ATTENDANCE

A minimum of 75% of the total attendance of the academic session would be necessary to appear in the Annual Examination, Shortage up to 15% may be considered for condonation in the case of genuine illness (if supported with Medical Certificate from a Govt. Hospital) or on account of participation in Vidyalaya/Inter-Vidyalaya activities or any other reason beyond the control of the student.

Article (61 B) Code of Conduct for Students

- (a) The following acts and conduct on the part of the students will amount to misconduct :
 - (i) Misbehaviour towards teachers or any other employee of the school.
 - (ii) Intentional disturbance of classes.
 - (iii) Absence from classes without the permission of the teacher/Vice Principal/ Principal
 - (iv) Bullying/Intimidation of others.
 - (v) Eve-teasing/misbehaviour towards girl-students.
 - (vi) Damaging/disfiguring school property.
 - (vii) Propagating a strike/disruption of classes.
 - (viii) Association with banned organizations.
 - (ix) Propagating communal/caste feeling amongst the students.
 - (x) Indulging in physical violence in any manner.
 - (xi) Disobeying lawful orders of the teacher/Vice-Principal/Principal.
 - (xii) Bringing unauthorized people/articles inside the school.
 - (xiii) Theft/pilferage of school/student's property.
 - (xiv) Indulging in acts of moral turpitude.
- (b) In above acts of misconduct, Principal shall take suitable action as per observation of the disciplinary committee depending on the gravity of the misconduct, which may include :
 - (i) Oral/written warnings to the student and parents.
 - (ii) Suspension from attending classes/school for a specified period.
 - (iii) Recovery of loss to school property.
 - (iv) Issue of loss to school property.
 - (v) Expulsion/rustication from school.

ABSENCE FROM THE SCHOOL

1. On working days and at school functions children are expected to wear the uniform prescribed for the session. They must come to school neat and tidy, else they will be sent back and will be liable to disciplinary action
2. Children are strictly forbidden to go out of the school during school hours without the permission of the principal.
3. Books, stationary, bag, tiffin-box etc. should bear the name and class of the child. The school will not be responsible for any such thing that gets lost.
4. Once a student attends the school he/she will not be allowed any short leave. In case of emergency, the child could be escorted home by the parents with the written permission of the Principal.
5. No student shall go out of the class without class-pass.
6. No student shall loiter about in Vidyalaya and disturb the teaching of other classes.
7. No students shall absent himself/herself without prior sanction of leave from the school.

FORBIDDEN PRACTICES :

1. Chewing gum/sweets in class rooms.
2. Rowdyism and rude behaviour.
3. Damaging school property.
4. Writing on walls.
5. Spitting in or near the school building/class room etc.
6. Students of the school are not to ride on scooters, motor cycle, cars to school
